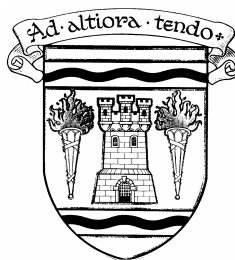

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

**Study Leave is from 27 November – 11 December inclusive.
The time at home should be used for revision.**

- You must know where the exam is being held.
- You must turn up for your exams 10 minutes before the exam is due to start.
- You must take only pens, pencils, rulers and any other necessary equipment to your exam desk. Other belongings should be kept at the front of the exam room.
- All mobile phones are banned from the Exam Rooms.
- You must remain quiet throughout the exam so that you do not disturb other candidates in the room.
- You must ensure that you go to the toilet before each examination as you will not be allowed out during the exam.
- You must not leave the exam room until told to do so by the invigilator.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM ILL ON THE DAY OF AN EXAM?

If you are unable to attend the examination due to illness, you or your parent/guardian must contact Hazlehead Academy School Office at the start of the school day. A doctor's line will be required to cover your illness. When you are well, you must contact the school for another date and time.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM LATE FOR AN EXAM?

If you arrive at school after the start of the exam, you must go to the school office. A member of the Board of Studies will be contacted and a decision about whether or not to allow you to go into the exam late will be made.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR FOR THE EXAMS?

Full school uniform is expected during the exams. If you do not wear school uniform then you may be sent home.

WHEN CAN I LEAVE THE EXAM ROOM?

You may not leave the exam room until the Invigilator informs you that you are now able to leave. As a guide only, for each exam the average timings will be as follows:

Foundation Level	30 minutes
General Level/Int 1	45 minutes
Credit Level/Int 2	1 hour

However, you should never leave the exam room until you have checked over your answers. You should have no blank answers.

DO I HAVE TO ATTEND SCHOOL WHEN I DO NOT HAVE AN EXAM?

You have been given study leave for the length of the exams. This means it starts on Friday, 27 November and you must return to school on Monday, 14 December. This time at home should be used to revise and prepare for exams. Pupils doing Art, Children & Families, and Hospitality will have exams before those dates.

WHAT SHOULD I DO BETWEEN EXAMS?

School goes on as normal for the rest of Hazlehead Academy. You are reminded that you should conduct yourself quietly around the school. The House Areas will be open for you between exams. You should not enter the main building unless you have to go to the office.

REVISION IN SCHOOL

If you come up to school to revise with a teacher ensure that you are in **full school uniform**.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I AM CAUGHT TALKING DURING AN EXAM?

If you are caught talking to another candidate during an exam, it will be assumed that you are cheating and the Invigilator will make a note of your name and mark on your exam paper that you have been caught talking.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I AM CAUGHT WITH A MOBILE PHONE?

If you are caught with a mobile phone, it will be taken from you and your parents contacted to collect it from the office. The Invigilator will make a note that you had a mobile phone on your exam paper.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I HAVE 2 EXAMS ON AT THE SAME TIME?

Inform Mrs Bonsall immediately and arrangements can be made for you to sit the exam on the clash days.

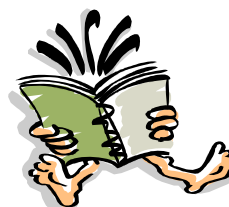

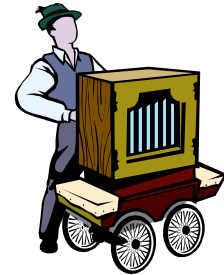
